What we have been up to:

We are aiming to achieve the Green Flag Award. In order to be successful, we have to make sure everyone in our school is eco friendly and gets involved.

Paper: We have been focusing on reducing the amount of paper we use: we no longer send paper forms home which has saved a massive amount of paper (and money)! We have added a paper recycling bin in every classroom to have easy access when needed.

Water: We have put water-saving devices into the toilets and we have calculated that this will be saving approximately 1500 litres per day!

Electricity: We have created zones in school and the eco members are turning the lights off to save energy when they are not in use.

Wildlife: We have put bird feeders at the front of the school to attract more birds around the area—this has been a great success and we are finding that we need to replace the food each week.

Next: We are currently discussing new ideas for Eco Activities—this year we are going to be doing an Eco Week instead of Eco Day, so that we can achieve much more towards our Green Flag Award.
