Payments

All payments where possible should be made online at www.wrexham.gov.uk/blacklane. Mrs Edwards is happy to give a tutorial to parents who haven't used the service before or are unsure. We are preparing to go completely cashless in the next 2 years and all payments will be available online. If you would like a reminder of your child's pin reference number please contact the school office. We recommend saving the pin number onto your phone or storing it somewhere safe.

In the meantime for any payments not available online cash will be taken but this needs to be in a sealed envelope clearly marked with your child's name and what the payment is for. Envelopes should be given to children at the start of each day and either handed to the class teacher or put into the lockable post box. Mrs Edwards leaves the office at 2.15pm so there is nobody here at the end of the day to give envelopes to.

If your child is going to be absent from school then we kindly request that you call the school office on 01978 757959. Class Dojo should not be used for reporting pupil absence. If your child is off school and no contact has been made then school staff will follow up with a phone call and may arrange a home visit.
