This week's sound is t: Can you cut and stick or draw something beginning with t Can you write t with a curly tail like this: t Can you draw a tiger? Can you write tiger?</p> <p>Can you write your name in tiger colours?</p> <p>Can you make some silly soup? Find a pan and fill it up with things beginning with t In my silly soup I have a train, a table, a tiger, some toes a tooth brush and a tube</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Story Time</u></p> <p>You could listen to "The Tiger Who Came To Tea" by Judith Kerr or "I Don't Want to go to Bed" by Julie Sykes and Tim Warnes. These are both on youtube Did you enjoy those stories? Which one was your favourite? What sound does tiger start with?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Outdoors</u></p> <p>Can you go on a treasure hunt outdoors. Find lots of leaves, sticks, stones etc. Can you make a pattern with the things you have collected? e.g. stone, leaf, stone, leaf</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Can you join in with a clapping pattern? e.g. clap your hands/ pat your knees/ clap your hands/ pat your knees Can you find any patterns in your house? e.g. stripy socks Can you make a tiger pattern? What colours do you need? Can you talk about the pattern?</p> <div style="text-align: center;"></div> <p>Can you copy and continue a pattern with your toys: e.g. red car, blue car, red car, blue car</p> <p>When you are really good at that see if you can copy and continue a pattern with 3 colours or objects</p> <div style="text-align: center;"></div> <p>Can you make your own patterns and talk about them?</p>
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical</u></p> <p>Can you make up a dance pattern? e.g. star jump, spin, star jump, spin. or, stretch up tall, curl up small, stretch up tall, curl up small.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSD</u></p> <p>Maybe you could make some yummy fruit kebabs in a pattern ~ e.g. banana, apple, banana, apple, banana</p>	
	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Creative</u></p> <p>Have a dance to your favourite music.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Welsh</u></p> <p>Can you remember the Welsh words for the colours you have used to make your patterns?</p>
