<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>This week let's remember our counting skills. What number can you count to? Can you count 3/ 5/ 10/ 15/20 objects? Remember to touch each object when you count it so you don't get in a muddle. Can you count to 10 forwards and backwards?</p> <p>If you are really good at all of those you might like to try counting to 10 in 2s and counting to 100 in 10s. 2, 4, 6, 8, 10</p> <p>10, 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 80, 90, 100</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Story Time</u></p> <p>Kipper's Toybox is good for counting. See resource sheet below for link</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical</u></p> <p>Can you do 5 star jumps? Can you do 10 claps? Can you do 4 hops? Can you do 7 jumps?</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Creative</u></p> <p>If you have a printer you could print off some big numbers to decorate (See resource sheet below for link). Otherwise you could draw your own.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Hand prints.</u></p> <p>Paint your hands and print with them. How many hands have you printed? Can you count all of the fingers?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Outdoors</u></p> <p>Can you make another collection of objects from your garden? Can you count them? How many leaves / stones/ sticks? How many will you have if you add 1 more? How many will you have if you take 1 away?</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Welsh</u></p> <p>Can you count using welsh numbers?</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>PSD</u></p> <p>Can you get ready for the day? Can you get dressed? Can you wash your hands and face? Don't forget to clean your teeth :)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>This week's sound is: h Can you make a simple hat? Just a paper band to fit around your head is fine. Can you decorate your hat with pictures of things that begin with h? You could cut pictures out of a magazine, print from your computer or draw them yourself. Wear your hat to hop about in saying h,h,h,h,h!</p> <p>Link to Jolly Phonics songs on resource sheet below</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics</u></p> <p>Let's learn: <u>Hickory Dickory Dock.</u></p> <p>Hickory dickory dock, The mouse ran up the clock. The clock struck 1 <i>(Make 1 big loud noise)</i> The mouse ran down Wheeeee</p> <p>Hickory dickory dock Tick tock tick tock tick tock tick tock</p> <p>Find different ways of making the clock's chime A pan and a spoon Clap your hands Your voice Can you make it loud and quiet?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Mark making</u></p> <p>If you have some flour, sugar, salt or rice, put a thin layer into a shallow tray and draw shapes, pictures a lines in it.</p> <p>For coloured rice, you could try putting some rice into a sealable freezer bag and adding a squirt of paint. Squidge around until all of the rice is coloured and then tip it out and let it dry.</p> <p>You could put paint into a tray and use fingers to draw into the paint.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p><u>Make a toys' tea party.</u> Invite some toys to a tea party. How many plates and cups will you need? Can you give each toy a plate and cup? How many cakes will you need? Can you make enough cakes for everyone out of playdough?</p> <p>(See recipe below)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Outdoors</u></p> <p>Blow some bubbles for your little one to pop with their hands. Great for hand/eye coordination.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>Story Time</u></p> <p>Can you choose a favourite story? Sit and listen to a short story every day?</p>
