Can you sort your collection into different types?</p> <p>Can you make a pattern from the things you collected?</p>	<p>Plant some seeds in your garden or in a pot.</p> <p>Collect the rain water to water them.</p> <p>Go for a picnic in the garden make some sandwiches using your cress.</p>	<p>Make some bird food</p> <p>How many things in your house can you spot that are plugged in and using electricity? Can you and a grown up switch some of them off?</p> <p>Can you catch some rain?</p> <p>Remember our welsh for rain is bwrw glaw.</p>	<p>Decorate a flower pot. You could use paint or stickers.</p> <p>Go for a walk. What can you see, smell, touch and hear?</p>	<p>Making junk models</p> <p>Can you make some musical instruments from junk?</p> <p>Can you make a shaker?</p> <p>Can you make a guitar from a box and elastic bands?</p> <p>Can you make a drum?</p> <p>Have a washing line exhibition - Paint some pictures and hang them on the washing line for everyone to see.</p>
