Maths focus - Subtraction/ Taking away


Reception skills	Year one skills
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
- Recite numbers up to 20, forwards and backwards, and from different starting points.
- Mentally recall 'one less' of a number within 10.
- Take away objects to find 'how many are left?'.
- Solve simple problems in a practical situation that involve simple addition and subtraction up to 5.


- Recite numbers up to 100, forwards and backwards and from different starting point.
- Mentally recall 'one less' of a number within 20.
- Add and subtract numbers involving up to 10 objects.
- Solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, including missing number problems, e.g. $7 + \text{ } = 9$, using concrete objects and pictorial representations.

- Subtraction using money to build upon last weeks focus. This can be done practically using coins to support.
- Lots of practical activities eg starting with 6 sweets/ grapes how many left when we eat one? How many left when we eat two etc.
- lots of counting backwards making it as fun as possible- count the stairs as you go down them, counting backwards in hops and jumps or when clapping hands. Start from different points to make sure your child really understands. Eg 6,5,4,3,2,1 rather than always 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, etc


2. Janine has 18p in her purse. She puts 10p in the collection for Comic Relief. How much does she have left?

Reception - WILF-


1. letters are facing the right way and are on the line.

3. Sounding out each word.


Year one-
