

Maths focus - Money

Reception skills	Year one skills
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Combine two groups of objects to find 'how many altogether?'</li> <li>Use 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins to pay for items.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use 'counting on' strategies to add two collections, starting with the larger number.</li> <li>use different combinations of money to pay for items up to 20p. (you can use higher amounts eg up to 50p if your child is able).</li> <li>Find totals and give change from 10p.</li> </ul>


- Naming and sorting coins- all 1p's together, all 2ps etc.
- Sorting coins using different criteria such as- more than 10p, less than 10p. More than 20p, less than 20p.
- Making price tags and then the correct amounts- playing shop, giving change.



Can you name each of the coins and explain how many pennies each is the same as? Eg – 5p is the same as 5 1p's.

Can you try and make as many different amounts as you can using a mixture of coins? Start with smaller numbers and work to bigger amounts but still less than £1 if you can. Eg can you make 10p? Can you make 12p? Can you make 56p? (Receptions will work with smaller numbers than year ones but if they are confident they can always work on higher totals).
