We started environment club and we planted some wild flowers and fed the birds and did a litter pick around the school.

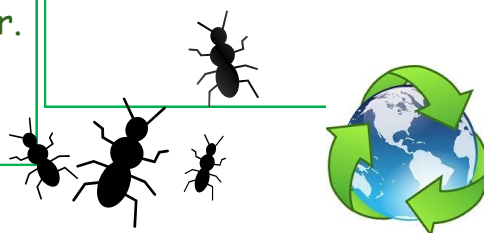
We recycle, card, paper and plastic and make sure we sort them into the right bin.
