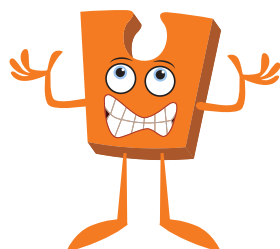




## Being Me In My World Puzzle Map - Ages 5-6

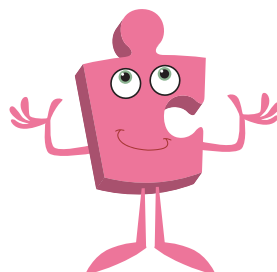

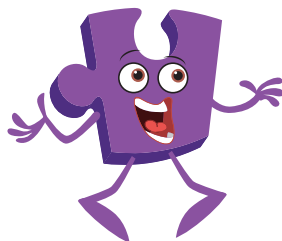

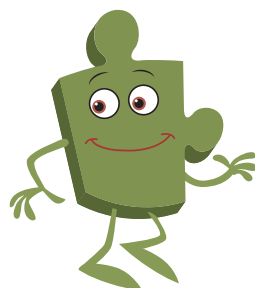
